



Lions Quest Educator Award

What is the Lions Quest Educator Award?

The Educator Award, supported by Lions Clubs International Foundation, rewards educators for successfully implementing Lions Quest programs in the classroom.

Who is Eligible to Enter?

U.S. Lions Quest trained educators in an accredited public or private school, or licensed after-school or other out-of-school programs, who have successfully integrated Lions Quest in their classroom settings, are eligible to enter. Employees, Executive Officers, International Directors and Trustees of the International Association of Lions Clubs and Lions Clubs International Foundation, Lions Quest U.S. Steering Committee members, Lions Quest Advisory Committee members, and Lions Quest trainers are not eligible.

How Do I Enter?

Complete the award application and submit with any applicable support materials to Lions Quest, 300 W. 22nd Street, Oak Brook, IL 60523. Entries must be postmarked no later than May 30, 2010.

Awards:

The Lions Quest U.S. Steering Committee will choose one finalist from each U.S. state represented. Finalists will receive a certificate and set of 25 student materials. One K-8 and one 9-12 finalist will be chosen as grand prize winners. Grand prize winners will receive a plaque and \$500 grant to be used in their classroom. Grand prize winners will not receive finalist prizes of 25 student materials. Grand prize winners and finalists will be notified by mail no later than August 1, 2010. Grand prize winners and one guest will be recognized at a ceremony held September 23, 2010 in Milwaukee, WI. Accommodations, transportation and meals will be provided.

How will entries be judged?

Entries will be judged on the basis of overall objectives, innovation/unique features and effectiveness. Judging will be conducted by a panel of representatives from Lions Clubs International Foundation and the education field.

Application procedures:

- Complete the award application. Confine description to the space provided.
- Materials such as lesson plans, support materials, newsletter, examples from students, and/or a ten-minute video on DVD may be submitted.
- Label all materials clearly. Include name, title, school or program name, address, phone, e-mail address, grade level/s included.
- All applications and materials become the property of Lions Quest and will not be returned. All entrants consent and guarantee that they give permission for their names, likenesses, pictures and materials to be used for promotional purposes without additional compensation from LCI or any other Educator Award affiliates.
- Team submissions are acceptable, however only one prize will be granted to the team, not to each team member.
